

Welcome to your chapter of the **Fay Club** History

Congratulations on joining TheFayClub! TheFayClub, originally the Park Club, was founded in 1881. Lucy Fay, daughter of George Flagg Fay, a prominent Fitchburg business man and charter member of the Park Club, donated their family home to the club after her father's passing. It was then in 1910 that the club was renamed The Fay Club.

The Fay Family house was designed in 1883 by English-American architect Richard M. Upjohn. In 1978 it was listed on the Registry of Historic Places and still serves as the home for all club activities. The club is the premiere dining and social club in Central Massachusetts and Worcester County.

OUR POLICIES

During the past century so much has changed. Whether you and your family have been long-time members or you are a new member, we thought we'd give you an overview of what to expect!

Billing — When you first visit the clubhouse we will ask you for a credit card to keep on-file. Once we have your information, you will be given a membership number. You may pre-pay your dining by loading funds onto your house account using this number. We accept credit cards and personal checks from our members at time of service.

Guests — You are welcome to bring guests with you at any time when you visit the club for normal dining. Events are also open to guests of members as long as it isn't a member only event and they are accompanied by a member.

Dress Code — Smart Business Casual is acceptable for lunch and dinner during the week. It is expected that members will dress in a fashion befitting the surroundings and atmosphere of our Club. It is also expected that members shall advise their guests of our dress requirements.

Technology — All electronics must be set to silent/vibrate upon entering the clubhouse. Cell phones must be used discreetly and phone calls are not permitted in the dining areas.

Children — The Club is a family friendly environment. As long as your children abide by the rules of the club they are welcome to join you. Legally children are prohibited from sitting at the bar.

Minimum — There is a \$175 per quarter food and beverage minimum assigned to each membership. Charges in excess of the minimum may not be carried forward to succeeding periods, and minimums not attained in a given period may not be made up in succeeding periods.

House Charge — There is a house charge added to all food and beverage invoices. This charge will solely be used to help with the upkeep of our beautiful clubhouse.

Gratuities — There is a 20% gratuity included in all food and beverage invoices. If you would like to tip additionally there will be an opportunity to do so.

Special Events — The club hosts events and special dining menus on a monthly basis. The club is also available to members for private events, parties, weddings, funerals, showers, etc.

These policies are reviewed periodically and any changes will be communicated to the membership as necessary. Please refer to our website for updates to our policies.
